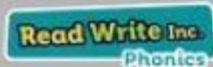



- To read their writing and check it makes sense
- To read aloud their writing to others

Grammar and Punctuation



Key objectives for Year 1:

- To use capital letter, full stop, finger spaces
- To understand and begin to use question marks and exclamation marks
- To use capital letters for people, places and days of the week
- To begin to identify nouns, adjectives and verbs in sentences
- To begin to use past and present tense correctly

Spelling



Key objectives for Year 1:

- To spell most of the HFW and Y1 common exception words
- To spell words using their phonic knowledge
- To spell words ending in –s or -es correctly
- To spell days of the week

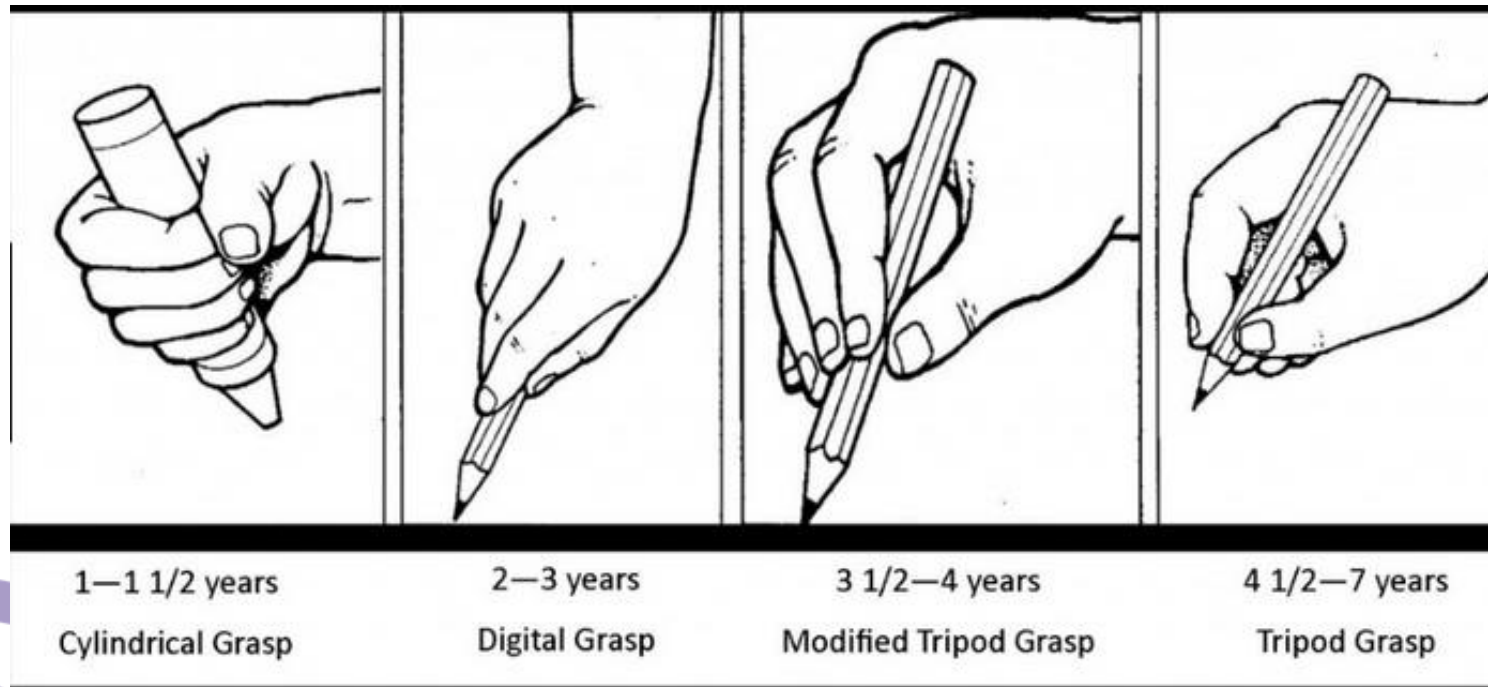

- To know number bonds to 20

Home Learning



- Reading – minimum 3 times per week (ideally everyday)
- Words on stickers (HFW)
- Phonics practise



ClassDojo



- Used to celebrate achievements in the class and showcase learning
- Share class news or messages
- In class reward system - each child will be rewarded when they reach: 25, 50, 75, 100, 125, 150 etc Dojo points
