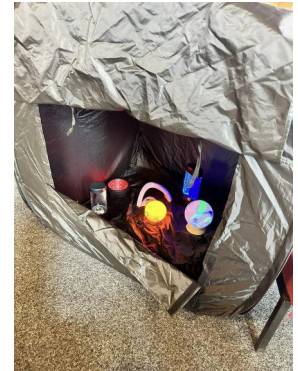
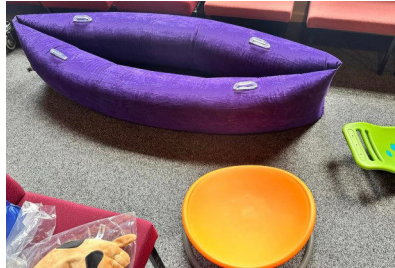


# SEND Newsletter
