Read Write Inc. Fresh Start



Fresh Start

Based on our Reception / Key Stage One Phonics Programme (Read Write Inc.), Fresh Start is a Phonics programme that supports children in upper Key Stage Two. Children who are working below age-related expectations receive regular interventions to improve their reading accuracy, fluency and stamina. With support from the dedicated Fresh Start Teaching Assistants, our children have been shown to make accelerated progress as well as improving their reading confidence and enjoyment. It is really important that school and families work in partnership to support all children, especially children with Special Educational Needs and/or Disabilities (SEND).

Next year, you will receive either a SEND newsletter or be invited to a family coffee morning/ afternoon each month.

Our SEND newsletter will explain a different area of SEND within our school in 'Spotlight on...'. You will also receive information about upcoming events or courses that may be of interest.

Family coffee meetings are held on a half-termly basis. Different people may be invited (such as School Nurse, Roots to Branches Autism Network) to offer further support.
