The MOVES programme (Motor Organisation—a Vehicle to Education and Socialisation) was developed and recommended by Physiotherapists and Occupational Therapists. It is an intervention for children who present with coordination, motor and organisational difficulties.

The programme involves a series of short exercises delivered by trained school staff. The exercises are shared with home to ensure the greatest impact for children.
